<a href="#">National Health Service Corps Scholarship Program (NHSC SP)</a>  Service Commitment	<p>The NHSC SP is a competitive federal program that awards scholarships to students pursuing eligible <b>primary care</b> health professions training leading to a degree in medicine (allopathic or osteopathic). In return for scholarship awards, scholars commit to providing primary care health services to underserved communities. The program provides support to students who seek financial assistance to complete primary care health professions education. <b>The NHSC SP pays for tuition and various other reasonable education-related costs and also provides a monthly stipend to assist with living expenses in exchange for a minimum of two (2) years of full-time service.</b> The service obligation must be completed at an NHSC-approved site in a HPSA.
